

KINGMAN RUN ROUTE

RIDE ROUTES AND MEETING TIMES MAY CHANGE WITHOUT NOTICE

Our rider check-in will be on Saturday, September 24, 2022 from 7:30 until 8:00am at the Mohave County Sheriff's Office, 600 W. Beale Street in Kingman.

From 8:00am until approximately 8:30am, there will be memorial ceremonies for the First Responders line of duty deaths in Mohave County. Once the memorial ceremonies have concluded, we will depart the Kingman area via Interstate 40 the Highway 93 exit. We will exit I-40 and continue south on Highway 93 to the Chevron Gas Station, 18035 Highway 93 in Wikieup (designated meeting location).

After a relief/refueling stop, we will depart at approximately 9:45 AM and will continue traveling south on Highway 93 to Highway 97. At this intersection, we will travel northeast and continue to the intersection of Highway 96. We will continue on Highway 96 through Skull Valley, Iron Springs to the intersection of 96 and Highway 5. We will stay on Highway 5 to the intersection with Pioneer Parkway (Highway 89A). Riders will continue on Highway 89A through Jerome to Cottonwood.

We will have a relief/refueling stop at the Maverick Gas Station, 690 Highway 89A in Cottonwood, until approximately 12:45 PM (designated meeting location).

After leaving the Maverick, we will travel east on Mingus Avenue/Conville Road (County Road 30) through Cornville to I-17. We will travel I-17 north into Flagstaff. At the intersection of south Plaza Way and Milton, we will left turn on to South Plaza Way and enter the shopping center parking lot. We will meet other riders and the Oregano's Restaurant 1061 S. Plaza Way. We should have an approximate 15-minute relief break (designated meeting location) before we depart for the barbecue.

Total mileage approximately 240 miles. Plan for approximately six hours (with stops) of travel time.
